

## THE WATERS

If you are up for a swim, the beaches in Vestermærk, Østerby and Sønderby are especially good for kids. The other beaches on the southern coast are less sandy, but still kid friendly. If you want to study the many different birds here, go to the parking area at Drejet or to Hartsø.

Fishing is especially good at Drejet and Kegsnæs Ende.

If you wear waders, Lillehav is perfect for fishing and wormdigging.

The waters surrounding Kegsnæs are fantastic for water sports and sailing. You can

kite surf, windsurf,

or paddleboard on the southern coast and in

Lillehav. At Drejet, you will even find a surfing school.

If you love to dive below the surface, you will find some of the most beautiful diving spots in the waters surrounding Kegsnæs.

Walking along the southern coast (which can be a little tricky due to the rocky beaches) you will find fossilized sea urchins, arm foots and thunderstones. If you are very lucky, you might even find some amber.

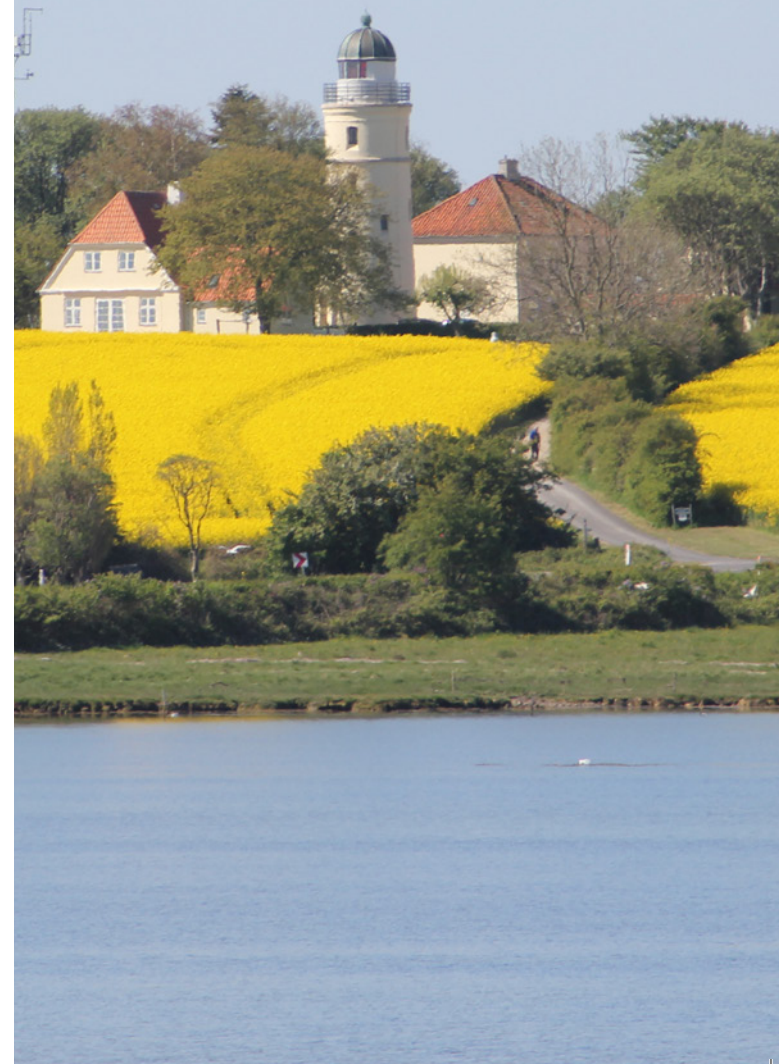

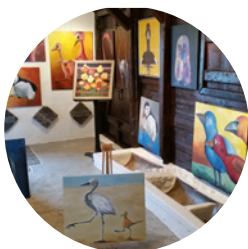
To fully explore Kegnæs, you will do best by bike or walking. On the map you will find routes guiding you around the beautiful nature.

Bodyfarm is a 'hyggelig' (cosy) and modern fitness center. It is equipped with all facilities in order to give you a good and all-round training.



In the crafts and art gallery Galleri Lillekobbøl, the whole family gets an unforgettable experience concerning art as well as architecture.

At Galleri GINKGO you will discover changing exhibitions with paintings and sculptures.



It is owned by the artist Kirsten Schulz, who offers art courses, art therapy, individual sessions, and painting. If you spot a small aeroplane or a model plane starting or landing, they are coming from Kegnæs International Airport,

which you are welcome to visit.

The church of Kegnæs, Sct Johannes kirke, was built in 1615. The church is open until 5 p.m.

On Sønderby Strand Camping you can rent bikes as well as boats, and you have access to free wifi and the playground - even if you don't camp there. Sønderkobbøl Camping and Sønderby Strand Camping offers fast food and kiosks. At Møllers Camping there is a small grocery.
